

**TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS
ORDER LIFTING BAN ON OUTDOOR BURNING**

WHEREAS, During the regular session of the Taylor County Commissioners' Court on September 27, 2022, the Court implemented a Burn Ban unanimously.


WHEREAS, In the Order issued that date, the Court authorized the County Judge or his designee the authority to release the ban when conditions allow.

WHEREAS, precipitation has fallen throughout Taylor County over the past 24 hours, and

WHEREAS, with the authority issued by the Commissioners' Court of Taylor County,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, ON THIS 31st DAY OF OCTOBER, 2022, I HEREBY LIFT THE COUNTY-WIDE BURN BAN.

Although I do not encourage burning at this time unless it is essential, I continue to caution all citizens of Taylor County to exercise great caution with outdoor burning and to assume responsibility to contact your local fire chief and have safeguards in place before attempting any burning. Any citizen who chooses to conduct a burn is liable for any and all damages caused as a result of that burn
