**WHEREAS**, I have consulted with the National Weather Service and some Volunteer Fire Chiefs in Taylor County in regards to conditions.

**WHEREAS**, there is power vested in me as Taylor County Judge to lift this Burn Ban when conditions allow.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED**, on this 3rd day of July, 2025, the Burn Ban is lifted effective immediately.

I ask all Taylor County Citizens to exercise caution and take all necessary precautions while burning.
